This new building hosts the administrative headquarters of Brussels Environment. It's one of the largest office and activity buildings to meet the passive standard in Europe with an Eco-dynamic work space and Technological innovations: photovoltaic panels, floor cooling-heating geothermal, natural light, double-flow ventilation with heat exchanger, and recovery of rainwater.
