Container ship arrives at the Port of Barcelona.

Containers are unloaded and transferred to the train

**Saturday 20:00**

Cargo train leaves the Port towards Madrid

**Sunday 08:00**

Cargo train arrives in Madrid

**Sunday 10:00**

Trucks pick up containers and transport them from the terminal to the nearby distribution centre in Madrid

**Sunday and Monday**

From the distribution centre the products are shipped throughout the world

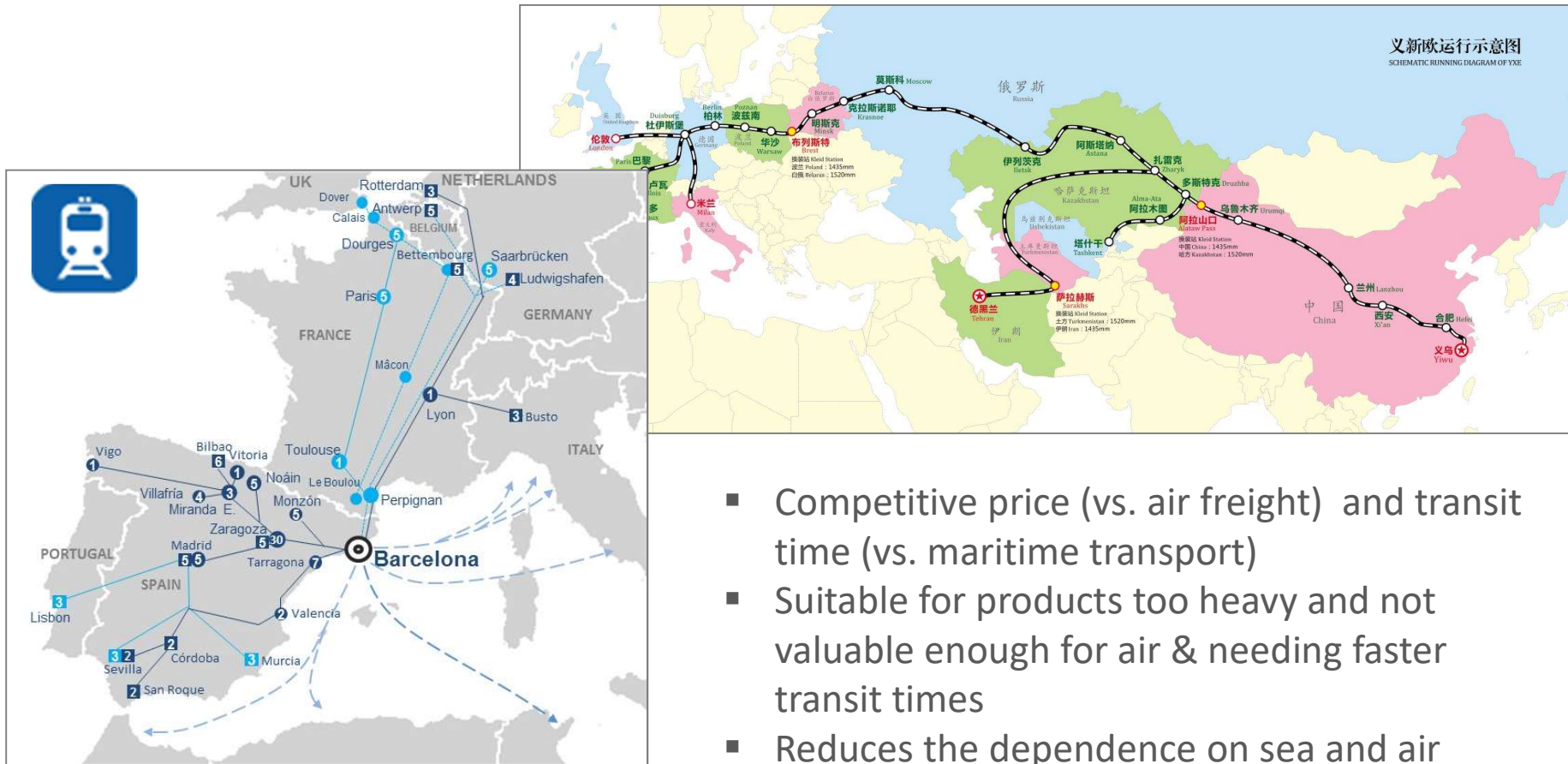




## Logistics chain through the Port of Barcelona serving Eurasian trade

- Competitive price (vs. air freight) and transit time (vs. maritime transport)
- Suitable for products too heavy and not valuable enough for air & needing faster transit times
- Reduces the dependence on sea and air transport
- Environmentally friendly
